Schmit, Bayley, Diesslin endorsed by Senate District 21 DFLers

(Red Wing, MN) – Local members of the Democratic-Farmer-Labor Party endorsed candidates for the Minnesota Legislature on Tuesday, May 24.

State Senator Matt Schmit (Red Wing) received unanimous endorsement to build on his record of accomplishment in a second term for Senate District 21.
